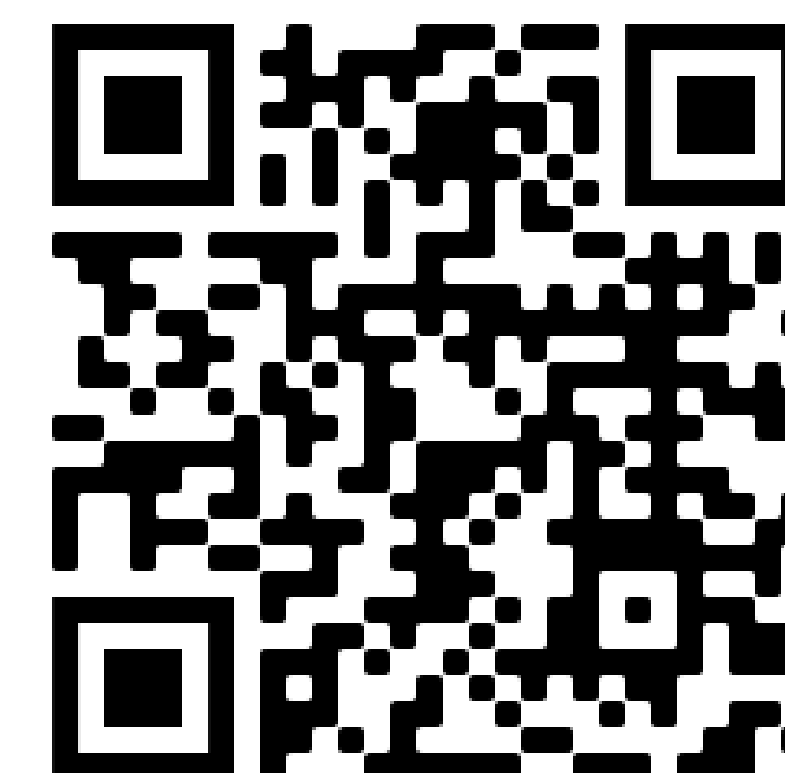

Why choose Summer and Winter University in Freiburg?

Freiburg ...

- **is easy to reach.** Long-distance trains (ICE, TGV) and buses stop in Freiburg, and the city is well connected to airports.
- **lies at a tripoint - in close proximity to France and Switzerland.** Not far from Freiburg (app. 60 km) are world-famous cities such as Basel or the European city of Strasbourg.
- **is the southernmost and thus also the warmest city in Germany.** There are many restaurants and pubs in the old town that open their terraces in the streets.
- **offers numerous sights.** The main sights of the medieval city include the Minster with its 116-meter-high tower, two city gates and above all numerous Bächle (small water-filled runnels) and narrow streets of the old town.
- **is famous for its world-renowned university** which boasts a 550-year history of scholarly excellence. Students from all over the world choose Freiburg due to its geographically blessed location, which makes the campus culturally diverse. Of its 24 000 students, around 4 000 come from abroad.
- **has been offering international language courses at the university for over 100 years.** It started in 1911 with "Freiburg Summer Courses". In the beginning, there were about 70 participants from 11 countries who only came in summer. In the meantime, the intensive language courses are also held in winter and host around 1000 participants from up to 60 countries in Freiburg every year. Coming to Freiburg to learn languages and get to know the country and its people thus has a long tradition.
- **as a Green City, has become a role model for sustainable urban development worldwide.** It is an eco-friendly city that has developed into a trendsetter in using renewable energy sources.
- **is the gateway to the Black Forest.** Nestled in the greenery, from here you can quickly reach the countryside. High mountains, lakes and streams invite you to linger and relax.
